

OMCCP Motions for BCAC meeting of July 13, 2017

WHEREAS the Province of Ontario has announced the [Ontario Municipal Commuter Cycling Program \(OMCCP\)](#)¹, a four-year funding program for cycling facilities oriented towards commuting, with \$42.5 million available to municipalities in the first year and a total of \$225 million over four years, and

WHEREAS the City of Brockville can gain access to this funding stream through a motion by Council and application to MTO requesting participation, and

WHEREAS a requirement of being eligible to receive project funding under the OMCCP is that Brockville have a Cycling Plan approved by Council, and

WHEREAS Brockville's Official Plan commits the City to the development of a cycling network of routes, and

WHEREAS the OMCCP will fund up to 80% of the cost of developing a Cycling Plan, and

WHEREAS the development of a Cycling Plan for the City will productively engage residents and other stakeholders in a facilitated and open public process, and

WHEREAS cycling infrastructure projects to implement the Cycling Plan, that would be eligible for funding up to 80% by the OMCCP, may be approved by Council and submitted to MTO following delivery and adoption of the Cycling Plan, therefore

MOVED that the Brockville cycling advisory committee endorse an application by the City to participate in the Ontario Municipal Commuter Cycling Program,

And

MOVED that up to \$10,000 of the 2018 committed capital budget for cycling be allocated as the City's investment in the development of a Cycling Plan for Brockville, with delivery targeted for Spring 2018, with funding for the balance of the cost to be applied for under the Ontario Municipal Commuter Cycling Program.
